- One-on-One Tutoring for Adults: Provides the additional help adults may require in order to achieve their educational goals.
- Read to Grow Children's Book Club: Have children enter kindergarten with the necessary pre-literacy skills and brain development.
- <u>Baby's First Book</u>: Emphasize the value of reading to children during the first five years of life. In conjunction with the Warsaw Community Public Library, this program provides an ABC board book along with early childhood literacy information and local library information to families of each child born at Kosciusko Community Hospital.
